- are located in communities that offer a high standard of living and host families that provide an excellent opportunity for international students to develop conversational English skills and experience life as part of a typical Canadian family
- provide carefully screened and selected local host families who are welcoming, caring and supportive
- provide programs with competitively priced fees for tuition, accommodations and medical insurance
